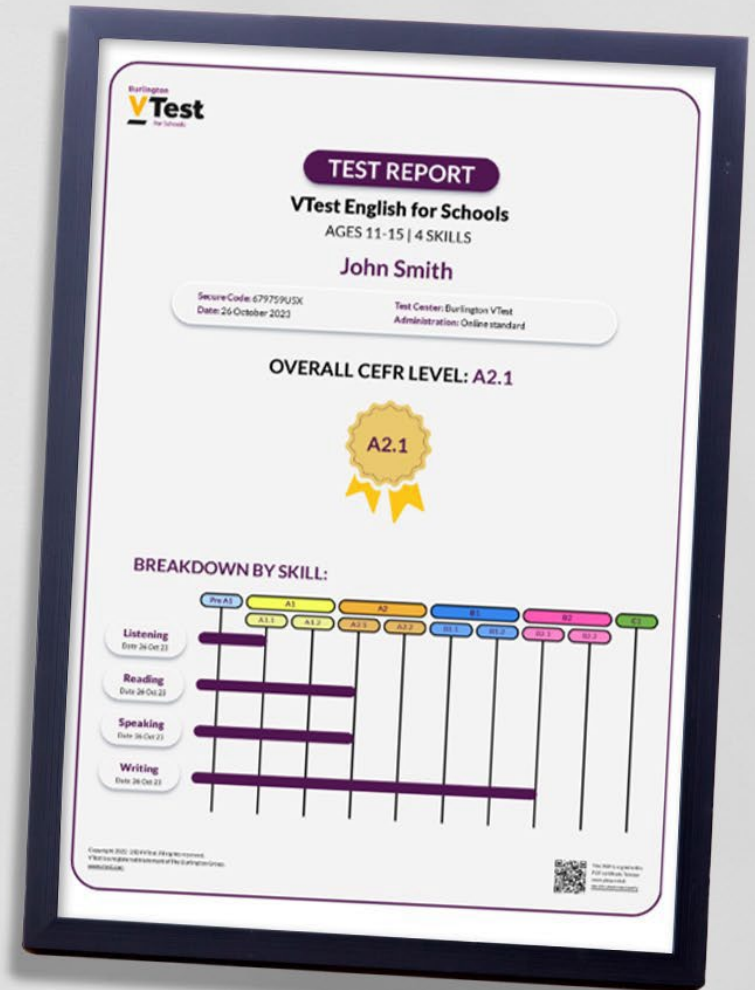

Analysis

Overall, this cohort of test takers demonstrated a range of English language proficiency from pre-A1 to A2.

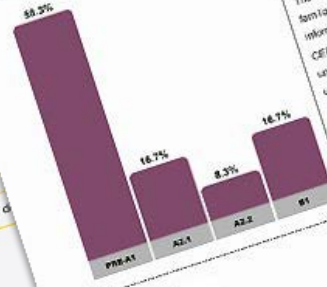
- Pre-A1** Learners at this level may be able to understand and/or produce isolated words and phrases.
- A1** Learners at this level can take part in simple interactions about familiar topics with a syllabus.
- A2** Learners at this level can communicate in simple and routine situations that require a direct response.

Language Skills Analysis

VTest provides an analysis of test taker performance in 4 language skill areas: listening, reading, speaking, writing. Test takers are awarded a CEFR level for each of these skill areas. The four sub-scores are combined to provide the test taker with a global CEFR level. An analysis of these sub-scores can provide schools with information about the language skill gaps of their students and provide insight into how to bridge these gaps with suitable language improvement programmes for learners.

Listening Skills



Analysis

Here the data shows that the majority of test takers (58%) were assessed at CEFR pre-A1 level; the remainder (58.3%) can recognise everyday, familiar words, provided they are delivered clearly and slowly in a clearly defined, familiar, everyday context. The learners who are at A2.1 (16.7%) can follow in outline, short, simple exchanges in familiar settings, delivered slowly and clearly. They can understand the outline of a simple information. CEFR descriptors for A2.2 state that language users at this level (8.3%) can generally understand the topic of conversation provided it is clearly articulated. They can understand simple descriptions and follow a series of instructions for everyday activities. Those who are assessed at B1 level (16.7%) can generally follow the main points of extended discussion provided speech is clearly articulated. These learners can follow in outline straightforward short talks on familiar topics. They can follow much of everyday conversation and discussion, provided it is clearly articulated and the accents familiar. They can follow a talk or presentation provided the subject matter is familiar.

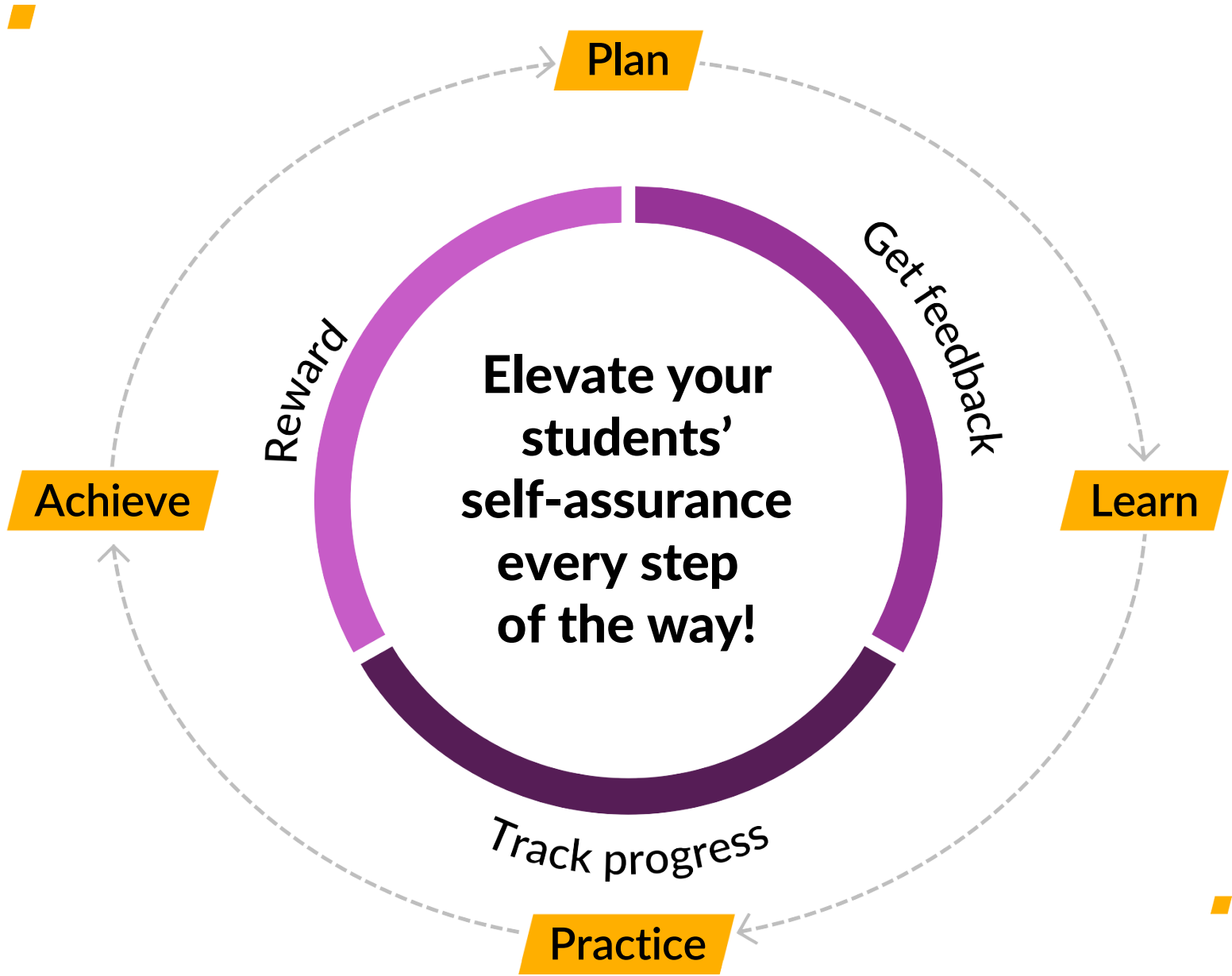
Reading Skills



Analysis

Here the data shows that the vast majority of test takers (83%) were assessed at CEFR pre-A1 level; the remainder (16.7%) at above pre-A1 level. The learners at CEFR pre-A1 (83.3%) can recognise familiar words accompanied by pictures, such as a picture book that features familiar vocabulary. The learners who are assessed at A2.1 level (16.7%) can understand the main points and some detail of short texts on familiar topics. They can find specific, predictable information in simple everyday material.
